WHEREAS, The Southwestern Ohio Educational Purchasing Council ("EPC"), an association of state funded, not for profit school districts and independent elementary and secondary schools, has completed an arrangement for a natural gas supply program with **Direct Energy Business Marketing, LLC d/b/a Direct Energy Business ("Seller")** for schools and school districts located in the ______ Service Area for the period of July 2015 through June 2017 with three possible one-year renewals; and

WHEREAS, Eaton Community Schools ("School Participant") is a member in good standing of the EPC; and

WHEREAS, the School Participant has reviewed the Natural Gas Sales and Service Agreement ("Agreement") attached hereto and incorporated as part of this ratification;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants and other good and valuable consideration, School Participant agrees as follows:

1. School Participant hereby represents and warrants that it is a member in good standing of EPC; and
