AGREEMENT BETWEEN

Preble County School Districts (Eaton, National Trail, Preble-Shawnee, Tri County North, Twin Valley South) AND

BUTLER COUNTY EDUCATIONAL SERVICE CENTER

The Butler County Educational Service Center (BCESC) and The Preble County School Districts will jointly provide services to students and families in need under the following conditions:

- 1. BCESC and Preble County School Districts agree to collaborative operation and delivery of services to children in Preble County.
- The BCESC will employ a Success Supervisor to oversee services to children and their families
 and to provide supervision of BCESC employees. The BCESC will also hire a Program
 Specialist who will oversee the program evaluation and communication with community
 collaborators.
- 3. The BCESC will provide 1 Community School Liaison for each of the 5 school districts in Preble County and will supply related supervision, training, laptop computer, travel and cell phone.
- 4. The School Districts will provide a private place for the liaison to work, internet access and networking at each school served, NT email account, and access to information for students online.
- 5. The Success Program Services will be offered for the 2016-2017 school year at no cost to the School Districts. Services have been made possible through funding from the Healthier Buckeye Grant, by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services

This agreement will be in effect from August 18, 2016 through July 31, 2017.

Both parties agree to resolve disputes over obligations set forth in this agreement as reasonably as possible. This agreement or parts of this agreement can be terminated by either party, provided that either party provide written notice to the other party.
