



SIDE ONE: DAILY ASSESSMENT FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF

Eaton Community Schools is asking each family to monitor their child’s temperature and health symptoms at home prior to arriving at school or boarding a school bus. Please take a moment each morning to check for COVID-19 related symptoms. If you check yes for any of the following items, you should refer to the reverse side of this document to determine if your child should attend school.

This guide is meant to help with daily checks as related to attending school and should not be used in place of a medical professional. If you believe you or someone in your household has symptoms of COVID-19 you should consult with your primary healthcare provider. If you are in a medical emergency call 911.

SECTION 1: Symptoms

<input type="checkbox"/>	Temperature 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sore throat
<input type="checkbox"/>	New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/ asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
<input type="checkbox"/>	New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
<input type="checkbox"/>	Chills and/ or shivering
<input type="checkbox"/>	Muscle pain
<input type="checkbox"/>	Loss of taste or smell

SECTION 2: Close Contact/Potential Exposure

<input type="checkbox"/>	Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes without face masks) with a person with probable or confirmed COVID-19: OR
<input type="checkbox"/>	Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes without face masks) with person under quarantine for possible exposure to SARS-CoV-2; OR
<input type="checkbox"/>	Traveled to or lived in an area where the local or state health department is reporting large numbers of COVID-19 cases.

SIDE TWO: SHOULD I COME TO SCHOOL TODAY?

Symptoms from SIDE ONE	Actions	Return to School
1. No symptoms/ No history of close contact with probable or confirmed COVID infection.	Come to school	
2. Close contact with probable or confirmed COVID infection (especially a member of the household who has a positive COVID test or a fever and symptoms of COVID).	Stay Home	<p>Per updated ODH guidelines – 12.4.2020</p> <p>10 Days Quarantined, provided no symptoms while quarantined.</p> <p><i>If the student receives a negative Covid test, they may be eligible to return after 7 days quarantined (if test is administered within 48 hours of the 7th day). Parents must contact the school prior to the child's return.</i></p> <p>Seek guidance from The Preble County Department of Health.</p>
3. Fever/ No symptoms of COVID/ No close contact with confirmed or probable COVID infection.	Stay home	24 hour fever free
4. ONE of these symptoms: New onset of cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing.	<p>Stay home. Seek healthcare provider evaluation and/or seek COVID testing.</p> <p>If at school, send home for healthcare provider evaluation and/ or COVID testing.</p>	<p>Provide doctor's note Or Provide negative COVID test result Or All of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 10 day ** isolation ● No fever for 24 hours ● Decreased symptoms
5. Any TWO of these symptoms: fever, chills, shivering, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea.	<p>Stay home. Seek healthcare provider evaluation and/or seek COVID testing.</p> <p>If at school, send home for healthcare provider evaluation and/ or COVID testing.</p>	<p>Provide doctor's note Or Provide negative COVID test result Or All of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 10 day ** isolation ● No fever for 24 hours ● Decreased symptoms
6. Any symptoms from box 3 and 4 above AND a link to COVID exposure.	<p>Stay home. See healthcare provider evaluation and/or seek COVID testing.</p> <p>If at school, send home for healthcare provider evaluation and/ or COVID testing.</p>	<p>Provide doctor's note Or Provide negative COVID test result Or All of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 10 day isolation ● No fever for 24 hours ● Decreased symptoms
7. Positive COVID diagnosis.	Stay home.	<p>All of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 10 day isolation ● No fever for 24 hours ● Decreased symptoms

QUARANTINE:** Stay in your home because you could be contagious. *ISOLATION:** Stay away from all others, even in your home; you are contagious. Questions related to quarantine procedures should be directed to the Preble County Health Department – 937-472-0087 option 3.

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
